



Sport Diver's ADVENTURE SCUBA CAMP 2009



Sport Diver's of Houston will be offering an Adventure SCUBA camp this summer (July 2009) for Junior Open Water Certified divers (generally, any certified diver under the age of 16). The camp is designed as an educational / adventure experience that will allow them to expand their certification to the level of PADI Adventure Diver. It will also help develop their diving skills by including dives dedicated to buoyancy, search and recovery, and navigation. Additionally, the divers will have an opportunity to try out diving with a **Sea Doo SeaScooter** (Diver Propulsion Vehicle). We will also have a field trip one day to Moody Gardens Aquarium. All transportation will be provided.

The camp is for 5 days, Monday – Friday, 8 am – 5 pm. Teaching staff will be at the store 30 minutes prior to and after class.

Dates of camp: July 13 - 17, 2009

Schedule: Class and pool sessions: M-W
Open water dives: Th & F

The pool sessions are conducted at William H. Williams memorial pool located in Webster. Open water dives are conducted at Twin Lakes SCUBA Park in Manvel, about a 30 minute drive from the Clear Lake area. Transportation to the pool and open water dives will be provided.

Camp fee: \$550 (includes: Book kit, rental gear, pool and park fees, certification fees, and entrance fee to Moody Gardens)

Each student will need to supply his/her personal gear which includes (approximate cost \$200):

- Mask
- Snorkel
- Fins & booties
- Weights / Weight belt

They will also need to bring a towel, bathing suit, and a desire to learn in a fun and exciting atmosphere. Each student may bring a sack lunch and drink or have the option of walking to Subway sandwich shop with the camp staff to purchase a lunch (please bring sufficient funds).

A medical questionnaire must be filled out for each student and, if conditions warrant, a physician's approval will be required.

Registration for the course is required before the ADVENTURE SCUBA camp start date. Parents must be available for approximately 15 minutes on Monday prior to the start of class. Paperwork, class fees, and medicals (if necessary) will be collected at this time. Parents will meet the instructor(s), view a short video, and pick up materials and book kits.

What you need to know:

PADI is the Professional Association of Diving Instructors and is the largest SCUBA certifying agency in the world. PADI courses have met the stringent requirements of the American Council on Education (ACE) and are recommended for college credit.

Parents, you are welcome to attend with your child.
